- ◇ A copy of the approved permit is to be kept in each vehicle that exceeds the weight limit.
- ◇ Responsible Party shall be liable for damages caused as a result of work authorized by this permit.
- ◇ Disregard of the Heavy Load Ordinance may result in fines, permit cancellations, or denial of future requests.
- ◇ Parish Roads are also governed by a Wet Weather Ordinance. Work may be stopped in wet weather.
- ◇ The Police Jury reserves the right to designate hauling routes.
