The Jackson Parish Police Jury met in special session Wednesday, January 10, 2007 at 12:45 PM in the Jackson Parish Community Center located at 182 Industrial Drive, Jonesboro, Louisiana. Members present: Carl Atkins, Eddie Langston, Darrell Magee, Nathaniel Zeno, Jr., and Troy Smith. Absent: Charles Garrett.

The meeting was called to order by the president, Mr. Zeno. Mr. Magee gave the invocation and Mr. Langston led the recitation of the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion Mr. Langston seconded Mr. Atkins to amend the agenda to include:
Letter of request of the La. Wildlife & Fisheries for use of the community center for a public hearing.
Repairs to courthouse sewer line
Motion carried.

Travis Ables addressed the jury concerning his poultry business and planned expansion. Robert Greer commented in support of the poultry farmers in Jackson Parish.

Motion Mr. Atkins seconded Mr. Magee to approve the request of the Louisiana Wildlife & Fisheries for use of the Jackson Parish Community Center on January 30, 2007 for conducting a public hearing on Caney Lake pending a letter of concurrence of the Jackson Parish Watershed Commission.

The following resolution was offered:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Leslie Thompson has submitted his resignation as Juror, Ward 5, Jackson Parish, State of Louisiana effective December 31, 2006 at 11:59 PM and it has been accepted by the Jackson Parish Police Jury; and

WHEREAS, His resignation has caused a vacancy in office and an election must be ordered and called to fill the unexpired term of office exceeding one year; and

WHEREAS, the governing authority of Jackson Parish, State of Louisiana, is given the authority and responsibility under the provisions of La. R.S. 18:602 to appoint a person to fill the vacancy who meets the qualifications of the office, and to call a special election to fill the vacancy.

NOW, THEREFORE, We, the Jackson Parish Police Jury, State of Louisiana, at a special meeting convened, resolved that Maxie Faye Monroe be appointed to fill the Juror position until a special election can be held to fill the vacancy.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a special election be called and held with the special Primary election date set for March 31, 2007 and the special General election date set for May 5, 2007 with qualifying dates set for February 7, 8 and 9, 2007.

By motion of Juror Carl Atkins, duly seconded by Juror Darrell Magee the above resolution was adopted by the following vote on this 10th day of January, 2007.
