

The Jackson Parish Police Jury met in regular session Monday, January 24, 2005, at 6:00 PM in the Jackson Parish Community Center located at 182 Industrial Drive, Jonesboro, Louisiana. Members present: Mr. Carl Atkins, Mr. Eddie Langston, Mr. Darrell Magee, Mr. Nathaniel Zeno, Jr., Mr. Leslie Thompson, Dr. Charles Garrett and Mr. Troy Smith.

The meeting was called to order by the president, Dr. Garrett. The invocation was given by Mr. Atkins and Mr. Langston led the recitation of the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion Mr. Smith seconded Mr. Langston to amend the agenda to include:

- Purchase of a used 5 yard dump truck
- Resignation of Theotis Martin

Motion carried.

There were no public comments.

The jury recognized Mr. Kenny Cobb, president of the Jackson Parish Watershed Commission requesting the jury's support in their attempt to change the slot and to proceed with the planned drawdown in September 2005.

Motion Mr. Langston seconded Mr. Zeno to approve the minutes of the January 10, 2005 jury meeting. Motion carried.

Motion Mr. Smith seconded Mr. Langston to approve the payment of \$21,500 to GNF Management for the Parish Mitigation Plan in accordance with the 2003 contract. Motion carried.

Motion Mr. Langston seconded Mr. Magee to appoint "Bo" Myers to the Jackson Parish Recreation District Board to fill the unexpired term of Marylyn Show (May 13, 2007) as the representative for the Village of Eros. Motion carried.

Motion Mr. Langston seconded Mr. Smith to adopt a resolution in support of the efforts of the Jackson Parish Watershed Commission and to authorize the president to correspond with local and state legislators and officials in support of the planned drawdown and changes in the slot limit. Motion carried.

Motion Mr. Atkins seconded Mr. Smith to reject the bids for the purchase of a used dump truck. Motion carried.

Motion Mr. Thompson seconded Mr. Langston to purchase a used 5 yard dump truck from United Rental, Inc. at a cost of \$16,250. Motion carried.

Motion Mr. Magee seconded Mr. Langston to accept the low quote of Culpepper Backhoe in the amount of \$13,480 for the approved 2004 Rural Development Grant for the Weston Water System pending submittal of proof of insurance. Motion carried.

Motion Mr. Smith seconded Mr. Zeno to approve the following purchase requisitions:
