AN ORDINANCE GRANTING A FIVE (5) YEAR EXTENSION OF THE CABLE PROVIDER FRANCHISE GRANTED PURSUANT TO ORDINANCE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to an Ordinance dated March 17, 1982, the Jackson Parish Police Jury granted a cable television franchise to Telecable Inc., d/b/a TCA Cable TV and its successor Teleservice Corporation of America, d/b/a Cox Communications;

WHEREAS, Teleservice Corporation of America, d/b/a Cox Communications, transferred the franchise to Cebridge Acquisition, L.P., d/b/a Suddenlink Communications; and

WHEREAS, the Jackson Parish Police Jury desires to extend the Franchise for an additional five (5) years.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Jackson Parish Police Jury, Parish of Jackson, State of Louisiana as hereinafter set out.

SECTION 1: The Jackson Parish Police Jury hereby extends the Franchise for an additional five (5) years beginning March 17, 2007 and ending on the 17<sup>th</sup> day of March 2012.

SECTION 2: Cebridge Acquisition, L.P., d/b/a Suddenlink Communications, is the current holder of the right, privilege and authority granted pursuant to the Franchise.

SECTION 3: Except as amended hereby, the Franchise shall remain in full force and effect subject to prevailing federal, state, and local law and is hereby ratified and confirmed in all respects.

WHEREAS, the Jackson Parish Police Jury will benefit from the collection of any additional ad valorem taxes collected with the assistance of the legal counsel contracted by the Assessor.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Jackson Parish Police Jury in a duly called regular open meeting does hereby authorize the Assessor and Sheriff to engage BRIAN A EDDINGTON, Attorney at Law as legal counsel for its benefit in the above referenced proceedings on a contingency fee basis, not to exceed 10% of the additional taxes, interest and penalties collected for its benefit pursuant to the decision of the Louisiana Tax Commission in the above referenced proceeding or by judgment of a reviewing Court and does hereby obligate and encumber an amount not to exceed 10% of the additional taxes (including taxes paid under protest), interest and penalties collected for its benefit for the payment of said legal fees.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Jackson Parish Police Jury that the Assessor and Sheriff be and are hereby authorized to pay said legal fees to the legal counsel contracted by the Assessor to provide legal services in the above referenced matters prior to or contemporaneously with the disbursal of any additional taxes, interest and penalties to it.
