The Jackson Parish Police Jury met in special session Monday, May 2, 2011, at 5:00 PM in the Dr. Charles H. Garrett Community Center located at 182 Industrial Drive, Jonesboro, Louisiana. Members present: Mr. Tom Goss, Mr. Eddie Langston, Mr. Kent Hightower, Mr. Nathaniel Zeno, Jr., Ms. Maxie Monroe, Mr. Ray Duck and Mr. Troy Smith.

The meeting was called to order by the president, Mr. Langston. Mr. Smith gave the invocation and Mr. Duck led the recitation of the Pledge of Allegiance.

There were no public comments.

The president opened the public hearing to receive comments from the public on the proposed Plan 5 for reapportionment based on the 2010 census data. Those making comments were: Mr. Danny Hinton, Ward 2; Ms. Sue Ann Williams, Ward 2; Mr. Wesley Horton, Ward 5; and Mr. David Creed, Director of North Delta Regional Planning & Development, Inc.

Motion Mr. Smith seconded Ms. Monroe to close the public hearing. Motion carried.

Motion Mr. Hightower seconded Ms. Monroe to table action on the adoption of Reapportionment Plan 5 for Jackson Parish. The president called for a roll call vote: Mr. Goss – Nay, Mr. Langston – Yea, Mr. Hightower – Yea, Mr. Zeno – Yea, Ms. Monroe – Yea, Mr. Duck – Yea, Mr. Smith – Yea.

Motion carried.

The following amendment was presented:

Purchase of a refuse trailer for the solid waste department.

Motion Mr. Smith seconded Mr. Duck to amend the agenda to include the purchase of a refuse trailer for the solid waste department. All voted in favor.

Motion Mr. Duck seconded Mr. Goss to purchase a refuse trailer from Travis Trailers per the January 2011 lowest bid price of \$54,019 for the solid waste department. Motion carried.

Motion Mr. Hightower seconded Ms. Monroe to adjourn. Motion carried.
