The Jackson Parish Police Jury met in special session Monday, September 19, 2011, at 11:00 AM in the Dr. Charles H. Garrett Community Center located at 182 Industrial Drive, Jonesboro, Louisiana. The meeting was called to order by the president, Mr. Langston. The invocation was given by Mr. Smith and Mr. Goss led the recitation of the Pledge of Allegiance.
