The Jackson Parish Police Jury met in special session Monday, September 20, 2010, at 11:00 AM, in the Jackson Parish Community Center in Jonesboro, Louisiana. Members present: Mr. Tom Goss, Mr. Eddie Langston, Mr. Kent Hightower, Mr. Nathaniel Zeno, Jr., Ms. Maxie Monroe, Mr. Ray Duck and Mr. Troy Smith.

The meeting was called to order by the president, Mr. Langston. Mr. Zeno gave the invocation and Mr. Goss led the recitation of the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion Mr. Smith seconded Mr. Goss to change the order of the agenda. Motion carried.

The president recognized Ms. Ann Walsworth, Clerk of Court. She explained her request that the jury change the polling location from the McDonald Recreation Building to the new Council on Aging Building.

Mr. Jimmie Rogers, representing the Council on Aging requested that the jury reconsider the relocation to the new Council on Aging facility. He stated that as a non-profit corporation, the Council on Aging Building was not a public building.

Ms. Dean Rushing expressed her concern over the relocation of the polling location. She also urged the jurors to work to inform the public on the importance of the passing Amendment #2 on November 2nd to re-allocate severance taxes to stay in Jackson parish for the maintenance and construction of road projects.

Motion Mr. Zeno seconded Mr. Duck to accept the lowest bid meeting all specifications from DuraTech Industries for a Model 9564 Industrial Horizontal Grinder in the amount of \$584,725 for the parish landfill, with the cost being divided equally between the solid waste fund and the landfill closure fund pending approval of the Louisiana Department of Environmental Quality. Motion carried.

Motion Mr. Hightower seconded Ms. Monroe to accept the quotation of Williams Welding Industries, Inc. in the amount of \$2,358 for the construction of a "white goods" bin for the Chatham Model Bin Site. Motion carried.

Motion Ms. Monroe seconded Mr. Duck to accept the low quote of Dodson Enterprises in the amount of \$3,875 for the extension of the courthouse maintenance building. Motion carried.

Motion Mr. Smith seconded Mr. Goss to authorize the president to engage L & L Catering for the Veteran's Day Program. Motion carried.

Motion Ms. Monroe seconded Mr. Hightower to approve the following purchase orders:

Motion carried.

Motion Mr. Smith seconded Ms. Monroe to accept the quotation of EDCO in the amount of \$3,500 for the spraying of the drainage canal, with the cost to be paid from the capital outlay fund. Motion carried.
