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The Jackson Parish Police Jury met in special session Tuesday, September 25, 2007, at 1:00 PM in the Jackson Parish Police Jury Meeting Room in the Jackson Parish Courthouse in Jonesboro, Louisiana. Members present: Mr. Carl Atkins, Mr. Eddie Langston, Mr. Darrell Magee, Mr. Nathaniel Zeno, Jr., Ms. Maxie Monroe and Mr. Troy Smith. Absent: Dr. Charles Garrett.

The meeting was called to order by the president, Mr. Zeno. Mr. Magee gave the invocation and Mr. Smith led the recitation of the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion Mr. Atkins seconded Mr. Smith to amend the agenda to include:  
Approve expenditure of \$8,900 to Meyers Water Well Drilling Service.  
Approve quotation of Dodson Enterprises for \$2,925 for concrete work at museum.  
Approve use of community center by Clerk of Court  
Motion carried.

Motion Mr. Smith seconded Mr. Magee to move item #5 (LCDBG projects) to item #16. Motion carried.

Motion Mr. Smith seconded Mr. Atkins to accept the resignation of Betty Duck from the Beautification Council. Motion carried.

Motion Mr. Smith seconded Mr. Atkins to appoint Laura Ables as District 6 representative to the Jackson Parish Beautification Council. Motion carried.

Motion Mr. Atkins seconded Mr. Smith to deny the request of Glen Henderson for reimbursement of damages to his personal vehicle while traveling to a job related meeting. Motion carried.

Motion Ms. Monroe seconded Mr. Magee to approve the payment of \$20,177.74 to the Secretary of State for the March 31, 2007 elections. Motion carried.

Motion Ms. Monroe seconded Mr. Smith to approve the temporary employment of Tommy Coleman in the building department as recommended by the building superintendent. Motion carried.

Motion Mr. Maxie seconded Mr. Carl to authorize the abatement of a nuisance at 1511 Julius Erving by D & D Fencing at a cost of \$2,300. Motion carried.

Motion Mr. Atkins seconded Mr. Smith to mandate the refund of all residential permit fees, residential plan review fees and residential inspection fees except those performed in connection with new residential construction or major residential renovations exceeding in scope 50 percent of the square footage; and to refund all commercial permit fees, plan review fees and commercial

inspection fees collected during the period July 25, 2007 through September 6, 2007. Motion carried.

Motion Ms. Monroe seconded Mr. Smith to approve the following purchase orders:

Motion Mr. Smith seconded Mr. Atkins to approve the payment of \$8,900 to Meyers Water Well Service for the LGAP Emergency Grant project for Southeast Hodge Water System. Motion carried.

Motion Mr. Langston seconded Mr. Atkins to approve the quotation of Dodson Enterprise for concrete work at the museum in the amount of \$2,925. Motion carried.

Motion Mr. Smith seconded Ms. Monroe to approve the request of the Clerk of Court for use of the community center on October 9<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup> for training of poll workers with fees waived. Motion carried.
