The Jackson Parish Police Jury met in regular session Monday, November 10, 2003, at 6:00 PM in the Jackson Parish Community Center in Jonesboro, Louisiana. Members present: Mr. Carl Atkins, Mr. Eddie Langston, Mr. Todd Culpepper, Mr. Nathaniel Zeno, Jr., Mr. Leslie Thompson, Dr. Charles Garrett and Mr. Troy Smith. Also present: Mr. Douglas Stokes, Assistant District Attorney.

The meeting was called to order by the president, Dr. Garrett. The invocation was given by Mr. Atkins, and Mr. Langston led the recitation of the Pledge of Allegiance.

There were no public comments.
