The Jackson Parish Police Jury met in special session Monday, November 15, 2010, at 11:00 AM in the Police Jury Meeting Room of the Jackson Parish Courthouse in Jonesboro, Louisiana. Members present: Mr. Tom Goss, Mr. Eddie Langston, Mr. Kent Hightower, Mr. Nathaniel Zeno, Jr., Ms. Maxie Monroe, Mr. Ray Duck and Mr. Troy Smith.

The meeting was called to order by the vice-president, Mr. Hightower. Mr. Goss gave the invocation and Mr. Duck led the recitation of the Pledge of Allegiance.

The following amendment was offered:

Define the unitary status of the Town of Jonesboro in reference to use of the community center with fees waived. There were no public comments on the amendment.

Motion Ms. Monroe seconded Mr. Duck to amend the agenda to define the unitary status of the Town of Jonesboro in reference to use of the community center with fees waived. Motion carried.

Mr. Stanley Sneed made public comments requesting that the jury require the removal of a locked gate on Applegate Road.

Motion Mr. Zeno seconded Mr. Hightower to go into executive session to discuss potential litigation. Motion carried.

Motion Mr. Zeno seconded Mr. Duck to return to open session with no action having been taken. Motion carried.

Motion Mr. Duck seconded Ms. Monroe to contact property owners with locked gates on Applegate Road instructing them to remove said gates. Motion carried with Mr. Goss, Mr. Langston and Mr. Zeno voting nay.

Paul Riley gave the engineer's report.

Motion Mr. Smith seconded Ms. Monroe to accept the engineer's estimate of road damage in the amount of \$56,201.00 caused by the construction of the ETC Pipeline and authorize the submission of invoicing for reimbursement of damages. Motion carried.

Motion Mr. Zeno seconded Mr. Hightower to authorize the Riley Company to perform the load rating of bridges as required by the Louisiana Department of Transportation and Development. Motion carried.

Motion Mr. Smith seconded Mr. Duck to authorize the engineer to inform the Louisiana Department of Transportation of the Jury's intent to assume ownership of the caution light located at the intersection of Antioch Road and Quitman Highway upon the transfer of ownership of the Quitman Highway. Motion carried.

Motion Mr. Zeno seconded Ms. Monroe to recognize all divisions/departments as a part of the unified Town of Jonesboro in reference to the usage of the community center with fees waived. Motion carried with Mr. Goss and Mr. Langston voting nay.

Motion Mr. Smith seconded Ms. Monroe to approve out of state travel request of the certified building official to Longview, Texas December 9-10 with all cost excluding travel being paid by the vendor for required continuing education units. Motion carried with Mr. Goss and Mr. Hightower voting nay.

Motion Mr. Zeno seconded Ms. Monroe to approve the following purchase order:
