The Jackson Parish Police Jury met in special session Monday, December 19, 2011, at 11:00 AM in the Police Jury Meeting Room of the Jackson Parish Courthouse in Jonesboro, Louisiana. Members present: Mr. Tom Goss, Mr. Kent Hightower, Mr. Eddie Langston, Mr. Nathaniel Zeno, Jr., Ms. Maxie Monroe and Mr. Troy Smith.

The meeting was called to order by the president, Mr. Langston. The invocation was given by Mr. Smith and Mr. Hightower led the recitation of the Pledge of Allegiance. There were no public comments.

The engineer gave the jury an update on the Mt. Pisgah (Harvey Hills) Sewer District.

Motion Mr. Goss seconded Ms. Monroe to accept the low bid of S Bar S , LLC in the amount of \$140,488 for the construction of a model bin site to be located at the intersection of La. 147 and Bear Creek Road. Motion carried.

Motion Mr. Hightower seconded Ms. Monroe to authorize the president to sign the final change order for the La. 542 model bin site contingent upon the original contract amount not being exceeded. Motion carried.

Motion Mr. Hightower seconded Ms. Monroe to authorize the president to sign the Substantial Completion for the La. 542 model bin site. Motion carried.

Motion Mr. Zeno seconded Mr. Hightower to reappointment Debra Jackson to a full term on the Jackson Parish Hospital Board. Motion carried.

Motion Mr. Zeno seconded Ms. Monroe to reappoint Claudean Cartwright to a full term on the Jackson Parish Industrial District Board. Motion carried.

Motion Ms. Monroe seconded Mr. Zeno to reappoint Marvin Davis to a full term on the Jackson Parish Tourism Commission and to appoint Bertha Robinson to a full term on the Jackson Parish Tourism Commission. Motion carried.

Motion Mr. Zeno seconded Ms. Monroe to reappoint Debra Jackson to a full term on the Jackson Parish Recreation District Board. Motion carried.

Motion Mr. Zeno seconded Ms. Monroe to place the Issuance of \$1,500,000 of Certificates of Indebtedness on the January 9, 2012 agenda for consideration. Motion carried.

Motion Mr. Hightower seconded Mr. Goss to approve payment of the invoice from the Secretary of State in the amount of \$2,622.47 for the October 22, 2011 election expenses. Motion carried.

Motion Mr. Zeno seconded Ms. Smith to authorize the solid waste superintendent to temporarily suspend the compactor truck for operating on Saturday. Motion carried.
