Mobile Home - Inspection Guidelines

- All inspections: A full 24 hour notice is required.
- Cancellations must be made a minimum of 2 hrs before the scheduled inspection. If an inspector arrives for an inspection and it is not ready, a fail will be given and a fee for re-inspection will be charged.

REQUIRED INSPECTIONS

- 1. Mobile Home Tie Downs
- 2. Electrical wiring from Meter Base Pole into the home shall be connected and in proper conduit or protection.
- 3. Plumbing connected to sewer.

All of the above shall be complete before inspections can be done on all New Mobile Homes being placed as well as Used Mobile Homes.

These same inspections are required when a Mobile Home is removed from a property and a New or Used Mobile home is put back in its place.
