Ward Four FPD Minutes, February 2021

A regular meeting of the Ward Four Fire Protection District of Jackson Parish was called to order at 7:00 p.m., on February 22, 2021, at the fire district's Central Station, located at 261 Hwy 505, Jonesboro, LA. This meeting was called to order by Scotty Nunn, fire district board vice president.

Fire district board members in attendance included Scotty Nunn, Billy Wayne Pullig, Marc Thomas, and Jimmy Tolar. Others in attendance included Scott Savage, Darrell Avery, and Heather Holland. There were no guests.

Marc Thomas presented the opening prayer.

There were no public comments.

After reviewing the minutes of the January 2021 fire district board meeting, Billy Wayne Pullig offered a motion to accept them as presented. Jimmy Tolar seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

The fire board next reviewed the February 2021 financials for payment. Billy Wayne Pullig made a motion to accept the report as provided. Marc Thomas provided the second, and the motion carried.

The board then moved on to new business, a proposal from the Weston Water System. The Weston Water System had offered the use of the water tank at the old Hwy 4 station. The fire district would have sole use of the water tank for use filling fire trucks during fire incidents. The board reviewed the project budget provided by the Weston Water System. The project cost would be \$96,000 to complete. After some discussion, Billy Wayne Pullig made a motion to the discussion until next month when individuals from the water system could be in attendance to answer questions. Marc Thomas seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

The board then reviewed the 2021 parcel fee collection. A total of 1424 parcel fees had been mailed for collection.

There were no board member comments.

The assistant chief was not present.

Chief Savage reviewed a few items with the board members including the need to move money to the district's reserve account at the next meeting as well as the truck construction meeting.

Jimmy Tolar made a motion to adjourn. Billy Wayne Pullig seconded the motion, and the motion carried.
