fire chief report:

CHIEF MICHAEL HEARD REPORTED AS FOLLOWS FOR JANUARY 2020:

6 EMS CALLS; 3 FIRE DRILLS DEALING WITH RESCUE TOOL OPERATION, SERVICE UNIT USAGE, AND A JOINT DRILL WITH QUITMAN FD ON SCBA INSPECTION AND TARP USAGE. THE CHIEF ALSO REPORTED THE TRANSFER OF THE DONATED CAR FROM EAST HODGE HAS BEEN COMPLETED AND THE CAR IS IN SERVICE. PUMPER #757 IS HAVING POSSIBLE ISSUES WITH GLOW PLUGS AND THE MACK TANKER IN EAST HODGE NEEDS BATTERIES. THE CHIEF ALSO REQUESTED AN APPROVAL AMOUNT TO USE FOR THE UPCOMING FORESTRY GRANT. THIS IS A 50/50 MATCHING GRANT WITH A \$20,000 LIMIT. CHIEF WOULD LIKE TO PURCHASE 3 RADIOS AT APPROXIMATELY \$1500 EACH. THE TOTAL WOULD BE \$4500 TO THE BOARD IN HOPES OF \$2250 REIMBURSEMENT.

THE BOARD DETERMINED REPAIRS SHOULD BE COMPLETED AS NEEDED TO KEEP EQUIPMENT READY FOR USE.

CONCERNING THE PURCHASE OF RADIOS AND OTHER EQUIPMENT PURCHASES THE BOARD DISCUSSED THE FUNDS AVAILABLE AND DETERMINED TO WAIT UNTIL AFTER THE FINAL PAYMENT FOR THE SERVICE TRUCK AND JAWS OF LIFE WHICH IS DUE APRIL 1, 2020.
