Regular Meeting

September 21, 2020

The Hodge Fire Protection District 1 Board of Commissioners' met in regular session Monday, September 21, 2020 at the fire station in North Hodge.

The meeting was called to order at 5:58 pm by Chairman Ralph Laffitte.

Approval of minutes: The minutes of the meeting of August 17, 2020 were approved on a motion from Mims and second by Howard.

Review and approval of expenditures and collections: The board reviewed and approved the statements of expenditures and collections for August 2020 on a motion by Howard and second by Mims.

Old Business:

Curtis Roller with BSTROZ1 Consulting reported progress on collection of past due parcels. Mr. Roller stated collections have been made and are continuing. 89 parcels were mailed with 19 collected. 123 still remain to be mailed.

New Business: None

Report from Fire Chief Michael Heard: Chief Heard reported 2 EMS calls, 1 house burning training, multiple calls to remove trees from highways during Hurricane Laura, assisted Jonesboro Fire Department haul water to the prison using 3 HFDP tankers for three days, and had 1 fire drill on scene determination. All HFPD generators were used during the power outage during the hurricane.

The generator has been installed on pumper 757 and repairs were completed on the tankers in East Hodge.
