Ward Four FPD Minutes, April 30, 2018

A regular meeting of the Ward Four Fire Protection District of Jackson Parish was called to order at 7:00 p.m., on April 30, 2018, at the fire district's Central Station, located at 261 Hwy 505, Jonesboro, LA. This meeting was called to order by Kent Hightower, fire district board president.

Fire district board members in attendance included Kent Hightower, Billy Wayne Pullig, Rel Mathews, Scotty Nunn, and Arthur Harper. Others in attendance included Scott Savage, Heather Holland, and Darrell Avery. Guest included Barry Dodson and Vicky Walker.

Scotty Nunn presented the opening prayer.

There were no public comments.

After reviewing the minutes of the March 2018 fire district board meeting, Scotty Nunn offered a motion to accept them as presented. Mr. Pullig seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

The fire board next reviewed the April 2018 financials for payment. Billy Wayne Pullig made a motion to accept the report as provided. Rel Mathews provided the second, and the motion carried.

The board then moved on to old business.

The board had received one bid for the memorial project during the last board meeting. The bid was from Dodson Enterprises in the amount of \$29,450. Mr. Dodson was present to discuss the particulars of the project. After some discussion, Scotty Nunn made a motion to accept the bid from Dodson Enterprises in the amount of \$29,450. Billy Wayne Pullig seconded the motion and the motion carried.

The board then discussed the 2018 parcel fee collection. Of the 1419 parcel fees that were issued, the district had received 1069 payments. There 350 parcel fees yet to be paid. The board discussed sending second notices to these individuals after researching the properties.

Billy Wayne Pullig made a motion to issue the second notices. Rel Mathews seconded the motion and the motion carried.

The board had no new business to discuss and moved on to comments. The board members had no comments.

The assistant chief was not present to make comments.

The district chief gave an overview of the month's training. The possibility of a meeting with a PIAL representative was discussed as well.

Billy Wayne Pullig made a motion to adjourn. Rel Mathews seconded the motion, and the motion carried.
