

The Jackson Parish Police Jury met in special session Monday, September 26, 2016, at 12:00 P.M., in the Police Jury Meeting Room of the Jackson Parish Courthouse. Members present: Todd Culpepper, John McCarty, Maxie Monroe, Regina Rowe and Lynn Treadway. Absent: Eddie Langston and Amy Magee. Also present: Darrell Avery, Assistant District Attorney.

The meeting was called to order by the president, Mr. Culpepper. Mr. Treadway gave the invocation and Mr. McCarty led the recitation of Pledge of Allegiance.

The following amendment was offered: Termination of a probationary employee for a violation of the jury's personnel policy. There were no public comments.

Motion Mr. Treadway seconded Mr. McCarty to amend the agenda to include termination of a probationary employee for a violation of the jury's personnel policy. Motion carried.

The president called for public comments. A resident of East Hodge requested assistance from the jury in blacktopping Main Street in East Hodge. Ms. Gloria Moore, a member of the East Hodge Council addressed issues submitted to the Jury from the mayor of East Hodge concerning the flood that occurred in March. The president stated that the jury had not received any correspondence from the mayor of East Hodge concerning the March flood.

Motion Mr. McCarty seconded Mr. Treadway to authorize the president to submit an application for the 2017-2018 LGAP Grant and a Letter of Support in the amount of \$50,000 for the purpose of asphaltting Main Street in East Hodge. Motion carried.

Motion Mr. McCarty seconded Ms. Monroe to authorize the president to submit an application for the 2017-2018 LGAP Grant and a Letter of Support in the amount of \$50,000 for the purpose of purchasing gravel for parish roads. Motion carried.

Motion Ms. Monroe seconded Mr. Treadway to declare the damaged culverts that were removed from Mosswood and Indian Creek roads as surplus property and advertise for sale by sealed bid. Motion carried.

Motion Mr. Treadway seconded Mr. McCarty to reappoint Freddie Tolar to a full term on the Jackson Parish Hospital Board representing District Two. Motion carried.

Motion Mr. Treadway seconded Ms. Monroe to approve the reimbursement to the Second Judicial District Attorney's Office in the amount of \$28,000 for office expenses for the third quarter of 2016. Motion carried.

Motion Ms. Rowe seconded Mr. McCarty to approve the following purchase orders:
