The Jackson Parish Police Jury met in special session Monday, October 19, 2015, at 5:00 PM in the Police Jury Meeting Room, Jackson Parish Courthouse, Jonesboro, Louisiana. The meeting was called to order by the president, Mr. Langston. Mr. Treadway gave the invocation and Mr. Bryant led the recitation of the Pledge of Allegiance. There were no public comments.

Motion Mr. Culpepper seconded Mr. Treadway to terminate Bobby Stamper, Jr. effective September 25, 2015 for a violation of the Jury's Personnel Policy. Motion carried.
