



Phase One Guidance-

Restaurant, Café, Coffee Shops, Bars/Micro-breweries with Food Service

- The 25% capacity requirement can be achieved by:
 - 10 person max OR
 - $\frac{1}{4}$ of the current number of seats OR
 - 1 person per 60 square feet of gross area
 - Tables should be placed 6 feet apart. Additional 2 feet is needed for space between tables where people will be passing through. Ten feet is needed between tables where people are seated back-to-back
 - No more than 10 people at a table together and they must be from the same household
 - Capacity includes employees and customers
- Spacing Requirements include:
 - Human contact as part of table service shall be eliminated
 - Do not permit interior waiting spaces
 - No contact between employees and customers
 - Avoid gatherings while entering, exiting or moving about
 - Kitchen and employee area capacity shall be reduced to allow for 6-foot distancing among employees
 - Indoor Live entertainment and dancing are not included in Phase 1
- Management Requirements:

- Actively enforce capacity and social distancing requirements
 - Ensure exterior waiting areas are not blocked
 - Check for fever or respiratory symptoms daily
 - Drinks can only be served to customers properly seated per above guidelines
- All Employee Requirements:
 - Wear face coverings
 - Wash hands often
 - Clean and sanitize items, carts, counters and frequently touched surfaces often
 - Keep at least 6 feet between employees and customers



Phase One Guidance-

Places of Worship

- The 25% capacity requirement can be achieved by:
 - 1 person per 60 square feet of gross area
 - Seating shall provide for 6 feet between individuals and small groups of members from the same household and other individuals
 - Avoid assigned seating within 8 feet of the center of the main aisle to allow for circulation and egress
 - Capacity includes church staff and customers
- Spacing Requirements include:
 - Human contact as part of the service shall be eliminated
 - Do not permit interior waiting spaces
 - Interior gathering spaces shall not be used
 - Avoid gatherings while entering, exiting or moving about
 - Outdoor service guidance remains active in Interpretive Memo 2020-24
- Management Requirements:
 - Actively enforce capacity and social distancing requirements
 - Ensure exterior waiting areas are not blocked
 - Check for fever or respiratory symptoms daily
- All Employee Requirements:
 - Wear face coverings



Phase One Guidance-

Salons and/or Barber Shops

**Salons and/or barber shops inside of shopping malls are to remain closed; no esthetician services allowed (waxing, facial, lash and makeup extensions)*

- The 25% capacity requirement can be achieved by:
 - 1 person per 110 square feet of gross useable area
 - Service chairs should be 6 feet apart (or customers can be placed with 6 feet of separation in another manner, i.e. skipping chairs). Where movement is necessary between chairs, 8 feet of separation is needed
 - Capacity includes employees and customers
- Spacing Requirements include:
 - Human contact as part of the service shall be limited to one employee per customer at a time
 - Do not permit interior waiting spaces; appointments strongly encouraged
 - No contact between employees and customers
 - Avoid gatherings while entering, exiting or moving about
- Management Requirements:
 - Actively enforce capacity and social distancing requirements
 - Ensure exterior waiting areas are not blocked

- Check for fever or respiratory symptoms daily
 - Facility must meet all current licensing requirements of the Louisiana State Board of Cosmetology or the Board of Barber Examiners
- All Employee Requirements:
 - Wear face coverings
 - Wash hands often
 - Clean and sanitize items, carts, counters and frequently touched surfaces often
 - Keep at least 6 feet between employees and customers



Phase One Guidance-

Fitness Center or Health Club

**Includes Aerobics, Yoga, Martial Arts, Dance Studios*

- The 25% capacity requirement can be achieved by:
 - 1 person per 120 square feet of gross area
 - Six feet between members at all times
 - Equipment and exercise areas need to be arranged to accomplish spreading individuals 6 feet apart
 - Reduce employee area capacity to allow 6-foot distancing between employees
 - Capacity includes employees and customers
- Spacing Requirements include:
 - No contact allowed between employees and customers
 - Do not permit interior waiting spaces
 - Avoid gatherings while entering, exiting or moving about
 - Outdoor areas may be used for non-contact activities with 6-foot distancing maintained
 - Limit locker room use to 6-foot distancing
 - Whirlpools and sauna shall remain closed
- Management Requirements:
 - Actively enforce capacity and social distancing requirements
 - Ensure exterior waiting areas are not blocked
 - Check for fever or respiratory symptoms daily

- All Employee Requirements:
 - Wear face coverings
 - Wash hands often
 - Clean and sanitize equipment, items, carts, counters and frequently touched surfaces often
 - Keep at least 6 feet between employees and customers
