Board Meeting Minutes
October 11, 2018

The Quitman Fire Protection District Board held its regular monthly meeting October 11, 2018. In attendance were: John Kavanaugh, Jim Justice, Bill Jimmerson, and Chief Philip Brown. Absent was Kelly Anderson and Joel Burnum. Public present was Kevin Spencer. There were no public comments. The financial report was read, Jim made a motion to accept the report as read. Bill seconded, all were in favor. The monthly bills were reviewed. Bill made a motion to pay the bills, Jim seconded the motion. Motion carried. Jim made a motion to approve the September meeting minutes, Bill seconded the motion.

All trucks and equipment are in good working order. Construction on the second stage of the Clay station is in progress with the completion date before the end of October. For the Radio Project, Chief Brown is working of the new license. The project was approved by the Quitman Town Council to put repeater on the water tower in Quitman. This project is to be done in the first quarter of 2019. The yearly apparatus maintenance, pump, and hose test was awarded to Fireserve and Procar. Bids on the equipment declared surplus in September meeting were opened and accepted. Mutual aid agreement for Bienville Fire District 7 was discussed and it was decided to continue to provide any assistance needed in the Mt. Olive area. Meeting adjourned. Next month's meeting will be held November 15, 2018.
