Public present was Charlie Edwards. The financial report was read, Joel made a motion to accept the report, Bill seconded the motion. Motion carried. The monthly bills were presented, Bill made a motion to pay the bills, Joel seconded the motion. All were in favor. The minutes from March's meeting were read, Joel made a motion to approve March's meeting minutes, Bill seconded the motion. All were in favor.

Chief Brown informed the board that all trucks and equipment are in good working order. There are a few 911 signs left to be distributed and the project will be complete. Construction on the Clay station is under way.

Chief Brown and the board discussed different options for the annual maintenance and service on the department's trucks and equipment. This as well as a security system for the Beech Springs station will be researched and decided at a future meeting. The new trucks will need to be outfitted with hoses and equipment. Chief Brown will order these items as needed. Charlie Edwards addressed the board about the possibility of installing a repeater in Quitman to enhance Communication for the department. Research will be done to see what this would entail and if will be feasible.

Joel made a motion to adjourn, Bill seconded the motion. Next month's meeting is scheduled for May 10, 2018.
