The Land Purchased in Ansley has been cleared and should start receiving money for the timber that was cut.

New business: Chief Brown presented the Board with two projects for the Clay Fire Station. Project A is for new construction of a 40x50 apparatus building at a cost of \$138,103.00. Project B is for a renovation project to the existing 40x40 building, in which will detail a 20x40 meeting area and a 20x40 storage area at a cost of \$70,125.00. Joel made a motion to except the quote from Pohlman & Wilbanks Contractors, Jim second the motion. All were in favor. Project will begin after the plans are reviewed at the January 11, 2018 meeting. 2018 yearly budget was also completed.
