The Jackson Parish Police Jury met in regular session on March 10, 1986 with the following members present: Mrs. Emma Jean Shively, Johnny McCarty, David McManus, Huey Massey, Roger Young, Ross Pullin, Kennie Bowman, Troy Smith, Lamarr Davis, and James Bradford.

The meeting was called to order by the President and the invocation was given by Mr. McCarty.

Mrs. Mary Kirkham came before the Jury to discuss Road 125.

Motion Mr. Bowman seconded Mr. Davis a resolution designating a certifying official to assume overall responsibility for the Environmental Process under the 1985 Louisiana Community Development Block Grant Program (LCDBG) for the Jackson Parish Police Jury,

WHEREAS, The Jackson Parish Police Jury has received a Community Development Block Grant from the State of Louisiana for water/sewer improvements; and

WHEREAS, Community Development Block Grant regulations require that recipients of funding take certain steps to comply with environmental requirements under this program,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Jackson Parish Police Jury in regular session that David L. McManus, President, be designated as Environmental Certifying Officer for the 1985 LDCBG Program.

This resolution adopted on this the 10th day of March, 1986 by a unanimous vote.

Motion Mr. Pullin seconded Mr. McCarty to approve the bills for payment and the minutes as published. Motion carried.

Mr. Gilbert Pickens, Fire Chief of the Quitman Fire District, came before the Jury to discuss the District and request that the Jury appoint two members to serve on the District Board.

Motion Mrs. Shively seconded Mr. Smith the following ordinance:

WHEREAS, The Jackson Parish Police Jury after a public hearing held on the 10th day of February, 1986, after disposing of all objections of all persons in authorities hereby resolves,

WHEREAS, the Quitman Fire Protection District ~~is~~ hereby created and be it further resolved that the boundaries of the Quitman Fire Protection District are fixed as follows:

Beginning at the Jackson Parish-Lincoln Parish boundary and the northeast corner of Section 23, R3W, T17N, thence south on the eastern section line of Section 23, R3W, T17N, continuing south on the eastern section line of Sections 26 and 35, R3W, T17N, to the northeast corner of Section 2, R3W, T16N, thence south on the eastern section line of Sections 2, 11, 14, 23, 26, and 35, R3W, T16N, to the southeast corner of Section 35, R3W, T16N, thence west on the southern section lines of Sections 35, 34, 33, 32, and 31, R3W, T16N, to the southeast corner of Section 36, R4W, T16N, thence continue west on the southern section line of Sections 36, 35, and 34, R4W, T16N to junction with the Jackson Parish-Bienville Parish boundary, thence north on the Jackson Parish boundary to junction with the Jackson Parish-Lincoln Parish boundary, thence east on the Jackson Parish-Lincoln Parish boundary to junction at the northeast corner of Section 23, R3W, T17N, which is the point of beginning.

WHEREAS, that after hearing the Police Jury of Jackson Parish does hereby adopt the Quitman Fire Protection District after concurrence by the municipality of Quitman and that the same be and is hereby final and conclusive as to said Fire Protection District and Jackson Parish,

WHEREAS BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that notice of the formation of the Quitman

Fire Protection District should be immediately given by one (1) publication in the Jackson Independent as the case may be.

Motion carried.

Motion Mrs. Shively seconded Mr. McCarty to appoint Mr. John Kavanaugh and Mrs. Melinda Pullin as members of the Quitman Fire Protection District Board. Motion carried.

Mr. Ron Riley, Parish Engineer, came before the Jury to discuss the Culpepper Road Project.

Motion Mr. Bradford seconded Mr. Massey to authorize the President to execute a Final Change Order establishing the final contract amount on the Culpepper Road Project. Motion carried.

Motion Mr. Davis seconded Mr. Massey to authorize the President to sign the Certificate of Substantial Completion and to pay the final retainage upon the Contractor furnishing the Jury a lien-free certificate in accordance with State Law and completing the final punch list. Motion carried.

Mr. Ron Riley, Parish Engineer, then discussed the Solid Waste Program.

Motion Mr. Young seconded Mr. McCarty to advertise for equipment and vegetation control. Motion carried.

Insurance proposals were then presented to the Jury.

Motion Mr. Bradford seconded Mr. Bowman to accept the lowest quote on each category of insurance and place the insurance with the Agency with the best quote on each category. Motion carried.

Motion Mr. Massey seconded Mr. Young to approve the request of the Jackson Parish School Board. Motion carried.

Motion Mr. McCarty seconded Mrs. Shively to approve the request of the Village of Eros for one of the old voting booths. Motion carried.

Motion Mr. McManus seconded Mr. Massey to approve the request of the Town of Chatham. Motion carried.

Motion Mr. Davis seconded Mr. Bowman to approve the request of the Village of East Hodge. Motion carried.

Mr. G. L. Edwards, Chem Spray, came before the Jury to discuss vegetation control on parish roads.

Mr. Travis Evans came before the Jury to discuss the Sheriff's Training Facility.

Mr. Bradford then gave a report on the Louisiana Police Jury Convention he had attended.

Juror Comments were the next topic.

Motion Mr. Massey seconded Mr. McCarty to accept the resignation of Mr. Bobby Swanner from the Jackson Parish Recreation Board and appoint Mr. Kenneth Frazier to serve the remainder of Mr. Swanner's term. Motion carried.

Motion Mr. Bowman seconded Mr. Bradford to thank Governor Edwin Edwards for coming to Jackson Parish for the Dedication of Caney Lake. Motion carried.

Motion Mr. Massey seconded Mr. Bradford that the body adjourn. Motion carried.
