

"Road Committee
December 7, 2015

The Road Committee met Monday, December 7, 2015, at 5:15 PM in the Police Jury Meeting Room of the Jackson Parish Courthouse. Members present: Mr. Culpepper, Mr. Langston and Mr. Bryant. Also present: Ms. Magee, Ms. Monroe and Mr. Treadway. Also present: Mr. Darrell Avery, Assistant District Attorney.

The meeting was called to order by the chairman, Mr. Bryant. There were no public comments.

The following was offered as an amendment to the agenda: To authorize the parish engineer to review Shenandoah Road for compliance with the parish road ordinance as amended. There were no public comments on the proposed amendment.

Motion Mr. Langston seconded Mr. Culpepper to recommend that the parish engineer review Shenandoah Road for compliance with the parish road ordinance as amended. Motion carried.

Motion Mr. Langston seconded Mr. Culpepper to recommend that the Jury declare Paradise Drive as a Class B Road, and based on the engineer's report that the road meets all ordinance criteria, be taken into the road system. Motion carried.

Motion Mr. Langston seconded Mr. Culpepper to recommend that the jury approve and authorize the president to sign a Change Order increasing the amount by \$2,709.56 for a final contract amount of \$2,387,792.07 for the 2015 road project. Motion carried.

Motion Mr. Culpepper seconded Mr. Langston to recommend that the jury authorize the president to sign the contract with the Riley Company of Louisiana for the 2016 road project. Motion carried.

Motion Mr. Culpepper seconded Mr. Langston to recommend that the jury reject participation in the La. Department of Transportation's Right-Size Program. Motion carried.

The following amendment was offered: Removal of Nig Dorsey Road from the parish road system.

Motion Mr. Culpepper seconded Mr. Langston to amend the agenda to include the removal of Nig Dorsey Road from the parish road system. Motion carried.

Motion Mr. Culpepper seconded Mr. Langston to recommend that the jury authorize the engineer to review Shenandoah Road for compliance with the parish road ordinance as amended. Motion carried.

Motion Mr. Culpepper seconded Mr. Langston to recommend that the jury conduct a public hearing on January 11, 2016 to receive comments from the public on the removal of Nig Dorsey Road from the parish road system. Motion carried.
