The Jackson Parish Police Jury met in regular session on December 2, 1986 with the following members present: Johnny McCarty, David McManus, Huey Massey, Roger Young, Ross Pullin, Kennie Bowman, Troy Smith, Lamarr Davis, and James Bradford.

The meeting was called to order by the President and the invocation was given by Mr. Pullin.

Mr. Donald Chatham came before the Jury to discuss Parish Road 330.

Motion Mr. Davis seconded Mr. Young to refer the Road 330 matter to the Road Committee. Motion carried.

Mr. Bradford addressed the telephone company representatives present (South Central Bell, Chatham Telephone, Century Telephone) about upgrading the systems and equipment in Jackson Parish.

Representatives of the telephone companies then discussed telephone service and equipment with the Jury.

Motion Mr. Bradford seconded Mr. Bowman to notify South Central Bell that the Police Jury is not satisfied with the 1989 target date to install electronic telephone equipment in Jackson Parish. Motion carried.

Motion Mr. Pullin seconded Mr. Young to approve the bills for payment and the minutes as published. Motion carried.

Motion Mr. Massey seconded Mr. McCarty the following ordinance:

WHEREAS, the Jackson Parish Police Jury after a public hearing held on the 2nd day of December, 1986, after disposing of all objections of all persons in authorities hereby resolves,

WHEREAS, the Ward 4 Fire Protection District is hereby created and be it further resolved that the boundaries of the Ward 4 Fire Protection District are fixed as follows:

Beginning at the southeast corner of Section 33, R1W, T14N, thence north to the northeast corner of Section 33, T1W, T15N, thence west to the northwest corner of Section 31, R1W, T15N, thence west to the northwest corner of Section 31, R1W, T15N, thence north to the northeast corner of Section 1, R2W, T15N, thence west to the northwest corner of Section 2, R3W, R15N, thence south to the junction with Louisiana Highway 4, thence west on Louisiana Highway 4 to a point 0.2 miles from the junction of the western section line of Section 35, R3W, T15N, from said point continue due south on a line running parallel to the eastern section line of Section 34, R3W, T15N, to junction with the northern section line of Section 15, R3W, T14N, thence west to the northwest corner of Section 13, R4W, R14N, thence southerly to the junction with the Winn Parish-Jackson Parish boundary, thence east on the Winn Parish-Jackson Parish boundary to the southeast corner of Section 33, R1W, T14N, which is the point of beginning.

WHEREAS, that after said public hearing the Police Jury of Jackson Parish does hereby adopt the Ward 4 Fire Protection District and the same be and is hereby final and conclusive as to said Fire Protection District and Jackson Parish,

WHEREAS BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that notice of formation of the Ward 4 Fire Protection District should be immediately given by one (1) publication in the JACKSON INDEPENDENT.

Motion carried.

Mr. Ron Riley, Parish Engineer, came before the Jury to discuss the Transfer Station project. He reported that the rain had caused a delay in the work.
